



The Narrogin arboretum was one of more than 50 demonstration plantings established by the then Forests Department, throughout the wheatbelt, in the 1950's and 1960's. The arboreta were developed to evaluate a range of local, regional, Australian and overseas species that were thought to have promise for planting in the wheatbelt and goldfields, with a focus on species for quality timber, dust control and for windbreaks.

The Narrogin arboretum, smaller than most, was added to over several years as new species became available, with the last trees being planted in 1969. Some species have prospered. Others have not.

Since the mid 1980's the arboretum became neglected and overgrown until the Friends of Foxes Lair took on the project in 2002. Regrowth and rubbish were removed, with the remaining trees being pruned and pegged. New species are being added including sandalwood trees.

Park at the Granite Car Park, which you can access directly to via Floreat Street then Range Road, or through Foxes Lair from Williams Road.



The arboretum has over 60 species of eucalypts that shows the diversity of this unique Australian plant.

Other species including introduced pines are also present. Tree numbers are shown below.
