



Located 32km north-west of Narrogin on the Narrogin-Wandering Road, the Old Mill Dam is a great place for a family day trip/picnic, and an excellent introduction to Dryandra Woodland. The picnic area has a gas BBQ, tables and interesting information displays. The dam is a great play spot for supervised children. Toilets are located nearby.



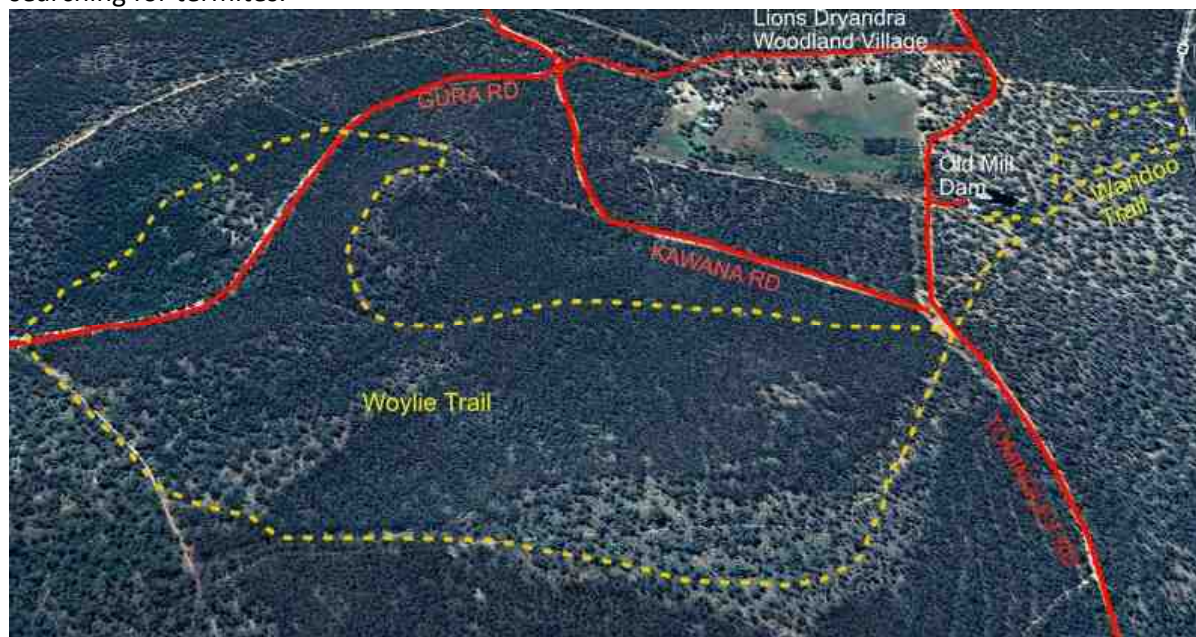
In the early morning and evenings kangaroo families graze and rest in the adjacent cleared area.



Two walk trails start here.

The **Wandoo Trail** is an easy 2.7km walk through wandoo woodland, which is suitable for families with young children. The map shows a part; a 1km loop with reflecting signs to enable people to see what is out at night. You never know, you may see the crazy possum!

The 5.5km **Woylie Trail** provides a good cross section of trees and wildflowers in Dryandra Woodland. It weaves its way through woodlands of wandoo, powderbark, kwongan heathlands, jarrah and stands of sheoak. Look for woylie diggings in the area and numbats and echidnas searching for termites.



Camping is not permitted here but you can stay in cottages at the adjoining Lions Dryandra Woodland Village, or camp at [Gnaala Mia](#) and [Congelin](#) campgrounds. Pets are not permitted.
