







SCAVENGER HUNT AT FOXES LAIR ARBORETUM

An **arboretum** is a place where different types of trees are grown for people to enjoy. Most trees here are Australian eucalypts (gum trees). The flowers on these trees have a special cap on each flower (**bud cap or operculum**) to protect them before they open.
